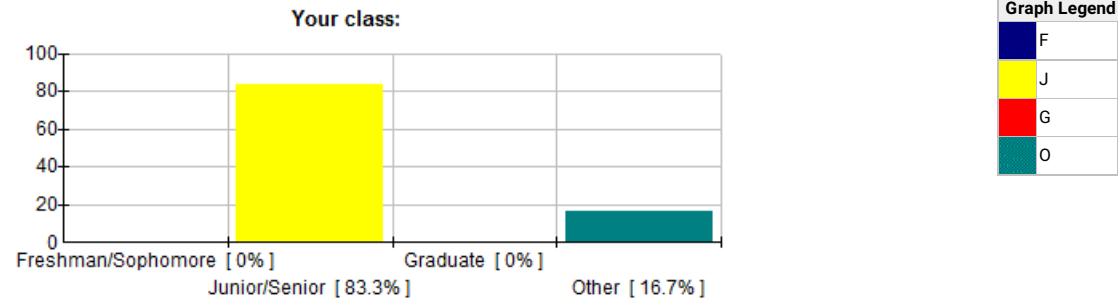
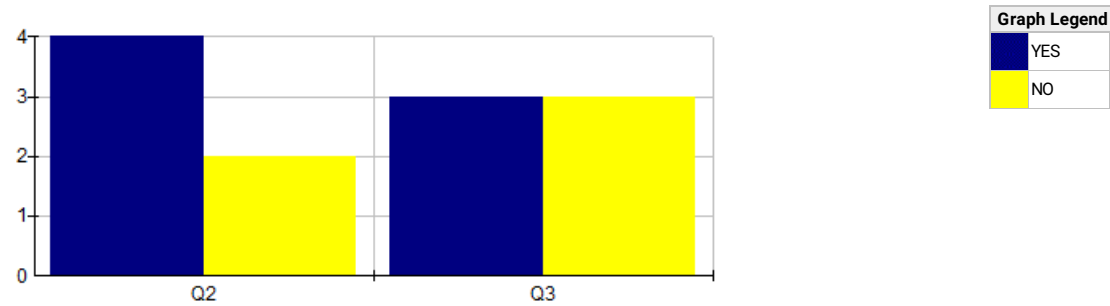

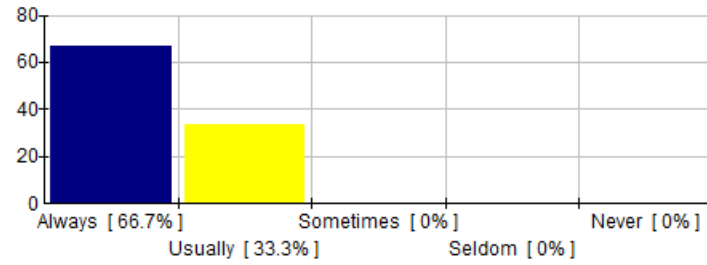

How often have you attended this class?

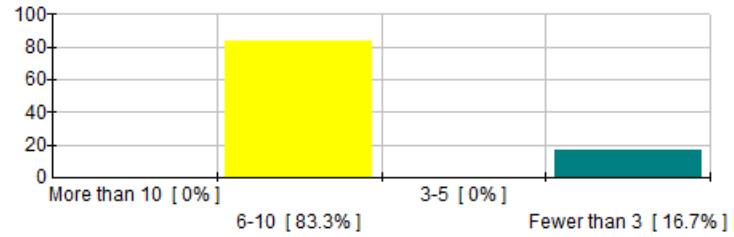

Approximately how many hours do you spend studying for this...



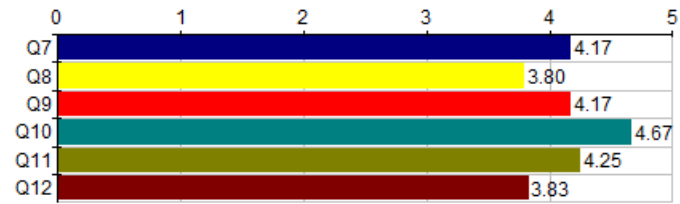

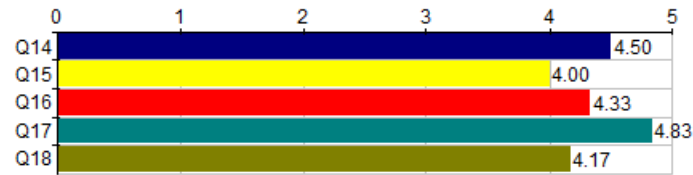
